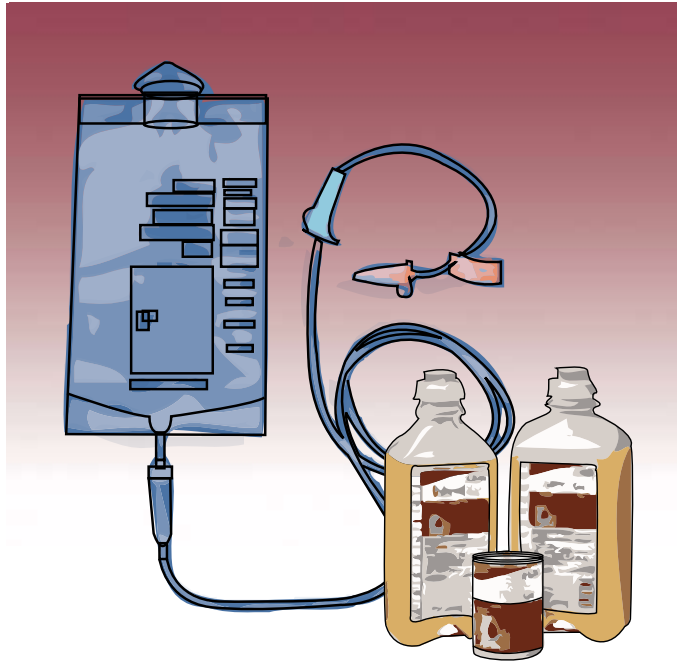


Enteral Nutrition Support



Simplify entry of complex orders

Tube-feeding orders tend to be more complex than just specifying restrictions for a diet order or selecting a nutritional supplement for a patient. This module provides the clinician with all the additional elements required to request a tube feeding for a patient. You can easily enter the necessary components including delivery routes, quantities/rates, frequency/duration, and formula strengths for either bolus or continuous feed delivery methods.

Designate different order types, such as standard or modular, so you can easily track and separate out orders that require special handling or mixing of base formulas and additives from ready-to-use formula products. You can schedule delivery of orders by day of the week or include special scheduling notes and even add multiple free-text notes, making it easy to include detailed information for special custom order instructions.

Enteral orders exist independent of diet orders in the Card File, so even patients without any diet order or those on an NPO order will still receive their daily tube feeding products. A Card File display symbol appears for any patient with existing enteral orders to alert staff to the special needs of these patients.

Nutrition Service Suite®'s (NSS) Enteral Nutrition Support module is designed to handle all aspects of enteral nutrition or tube-feeding orders for hospitalized patients who require this specialized nutrition therapy. The module helps streamline preparation and delivery of required tube-feeding products while also ensuring the proper amounts are delivered to the right patients.

The module includes features to

- Record/maintain tube-feeding orders separate from diet orders in the Card File
- Calculate the total number of units of product needed by the patient per day
- Summarize daily product needs by nursing unit
- Design labels to meet patient safety guidelines
- Issue products to fulfill all patient orders or just new orders
- Print labels for all issued products
- Keep a historical record of each patient's enteral feedings
- Track costs and assist with generating billing data

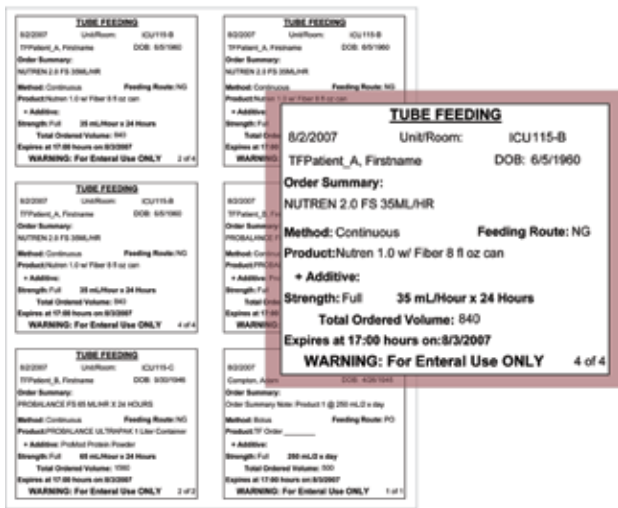

User-defined label creation tools let you configure labels with second identifiers (e.g., patient name and date of birth), special warning messages, and clear expiration dates to support The Joint Commission National Patient Safety Goals.



Track products and control costs

An enteral history view in the card file lets you track and review a complete history of all formula products issued to each patient. The view displays the total number of units issued for each product along with details on the cost per unit. It also summarizes the total cost of all issued tube feedings by service date for the current admission.

If any products were designated as billable, the billing price details and totals by service date are also displayed. A view detail option lets you review a complete audit of any single product that has been issued. With the adjustment option, you can even enter billing overrides or make quantity and price adjustments, if necessary. All these tools make it easy to identify how tube feeding products contribute to overall patient costs.

In addition, the module lets you generate many reports that summarize and analyze the use of enteral nutrition products and provide clinical staff with the necessary information to monitor all nutrition support patients.

Reports include

- Enteral Formula List
- Enteral Orders Delivery Summary
- Enteral Orders Summary
- Enteral Product Usage Summary

To assist your clinical staff, other NSS reports have also been enhanced to include information for patients with active enteral orders, such as the Clinical Workload Report and Patient Meal Worksheet.
